Local Law 2 of 2008

A local law amending Chapter 59 (“Ethics, Code of”), section 59-5(A) to provide that members of the Board of Ethics shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Board of Trustees, shall be persons other than officers or employees of the Village of Muttontown, shall serve for fixed, staggered terms of three years, and shall elect a chairperson annually; and adding Chapter 59 (“Ethics, Code of”), section 59-8 to provide that the provisions of this Local Law are intended to supersede and replace any inconsistent provisions of state or local law.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Muttontown as follows:

Chapter 59: Ethics, Code of

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Muttontown 11-9-1970 by L.L. No. 1-1970; amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 59-5. Board of Ethics.

- A. There is hereby established a Board of Ethics consisting of three members to be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Board of Trustees. Members of the Board of Ethics shall serve without compensation. No member of the Board of Ethics shall hold elective office or other appointed office in the Village of Muttontown, nor be an employee of the Village. The terms of office of members of the Board of Ethics shall be three years and shall run from July 1 through June 30 except that, of the members first appointed after the effective date of this Local Law 2 of 2008, one member shall serve until June 30 of the first year following the year in which the appointment is made, one shall serve until June 30 of the second year following the year in which the appointment is made, and one shall serve until June 30 of the third year following the year in which the appointment is made. At its first meeting each year, the Board of Ethics shall elect a chairperson for that year from among its members.

§ 59-8. Supersession.

Pursuant to the N.Y. Municipal Home Rule Law Section 22, the provisions of this Local Law 2 of 2008 are intended to supersede and replace any inconsistent provisions of any


state or local law, including but not limited to N.Y. General Municipal Law Section 808, and the provisions of the Code of the Village of Muttontown that are inconsistent herewith.

This local law is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.


